Artist Statement:

The 2017 Lenten season found me in transition, adrift, uncertain. In the morning stillness of my daily walk I saw God's eternal changelessness in this ordinary view of Puget Sound: always the same yet always different. I felt God inviting me to take in each day's beauty, like these images. As our daily activities of waking, eating, working, playing, sleeping blur together, there is reassurance in the same-ness of it all, yet each day is surprisingly different: each one offering its own unique beauty.

Our breakfast tastes different depending on how we slept, what happened yesterday, what news we may have heard upon waking; similarly, the clouds and light change the appearance of Puget Sound and its islands and peninsulas. Yet each day is a new gift from God that he invites to enjoy.

Each of these photos was taken from the same vantage point, in the same direction, at approximately the same time of day each morning during this past season of Lent.

Spend some time with each one. How are they the same? How are they different?

May each of us observe and appreciate the days God has given us, until the Great Easter.
