

Bethany VBC 2021 Safety Information & Agreement

*** Family Information and what to pack on the second page.**

Drop-off / Pick-up

All students will be dropped off in front of the church on Queen Anne Ave, or around the corner on Howe. Kids and volunteers will gather on the front lawn to start program at 9:30am. At 10am 1st through 5th graders will walk to Little Howe Park with adult and youth volunteers, preschoolers and kindergartners will stay on the Bethany lawn. Elementary students will return for pick-up at Bethany by 12pm. If you are picking up an elementary student before 12pm, please let Bianca know.

Safety

We will not be **singing** out loud during VBC. Preschoolers and kindergartners will only go inside Bethany Church to use the **restroom** where they will sanitize their hands before returning outside. At least two adult volunteers will accompany children inside the building and help in the restroom if needed. Elementary students will use the Little Howe Park restroom. We will provide hand sanitizer. Students will be offered a little **snack** and eat spread apart with only their class. Pack a full **water bottle** from home. Please let your child know that we are keeping at least **3 feet apart** (maybe practice before VBC), adult and youth volunteers will do their best to keep students apart during activities and down time. Please apply your child's **sunscreen** before drop-off.

Every box needs to be checked and agreed to in order for your child to attend VBC.

- I understand that Covid-19 is a real and a potentially harmful virus.
- I will not send my child to VBC if they or a family member present any symptoms below. If my child presents any of these symptoms during VBC, I will immediately return to Bethany and pick my child up.
 - Fever or chills (99.9 degrees F. as defined by the CDC)
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue, Headache
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- If I discover that we have been exposed to Covid-19, I will immediately notify the CFM Director, Bianca Quezada, and I will not send my child to VBC until I receive permission from Bianca.
- I understand that my child will be required to **wear a mask at all times** while at VBC except when drinking or eating.
- I will wear a mask whenever visiting VBC.

Waiver

I give my permission for my child(ren), listed below, to participate in Bethany Presbyterian Church's Vacation Bible Camp, August 2-6, 2021. I wish to make clear our understanding that Bethany Presbyterian Church, Seattle, Washington and the leaders of and volunteers at these events are hereby relieved from any liability for loss of property, damage to property, or any personal harm that may come to my child(ren), and absolve the church, service sites, leaders and volunteers and hold them harmless from any claim or demand which might be asserted in connection with Bethany's VBC. In case of medical emergency, I hereby authorize any medical and/or surgical care, including diagnosis and treatment, to be given by any licensed hospital or clinic, when my child(ren) is accompanied by a church leader or adult volunteer and efforts have been made to contact me. I assume full responsibility for such care.
